"Idealistic perception" has to do with recognizing ideas through manifested ideals, to see the ideal as real world expression of an idea. As I began to think about this, I thought of Nelson Mandela's *Truth and Reconciliation Commission*. Mandela was as concerned with truth as he was with forgiveness, and was aware that healing would only come from honest confrontation with what actually happened. When I think about this action, and what it did for many of the people living in South Africa, I see an ideal. When we can perceive the ideal, we can eventually come to an understanding of the idea behind the ideal. In this case, the healing of humanity will come when each and every personality is able to face the darkest parts of the self, and illuminate them, cleanse them, and then move up to the light of the Self.

Vogel Alcove was founded in 1987 by a group of people who realized that the way out of a life of poverty and hopelessness was through education and nurture of children. By providing child care and early education for their children, the parents are able to pursue jobs and opportunities to pull themselves up out of homelessness. I see this as a little microcosm of that better world in a new age of Oneness. "As you have done it unto one of the least of these, you have done it unto me"

The recent outbreak of Ebola in West Africa has immediately drawn the collective attention, the response from medical doctors and scientists around the world, and, particularly, the action of *Doctors Without Borders*. They have been responding to the urgency selflessly and lovingly. One can surely identify the contribution they make to the divine Plan as responding to the principles of the New Group of World Servers.

In the symbol of the Law of Service, we see how the server doesn't struggle with the heavy load of the jug and spill it randomly, but holds it ever in perfect balance, serving with purpose and determination. Service is the defining characteristic of the Soul just as desire is that of the personality; it spontaneously arises from true and sustained Soul contact. I find it enlightening to recognize that trends we already see in society are results of a nascent awakening of the urge to serve and it's expression. The Law of Service expresses the unfolding of "the consciousness of the heart", leading to Group awareness, which is the quality that leads to service.
