

I had a refreshing insight into the principle of forgiveness and reconciliation (to offset retaliation) by listening to Malala Yousafzai, the 16-year-old girl from Pakistan who has become a global advocate for the education of girls. When asked what she would do (before she was actually shot) if a member of the Taliban came to her house and threatened to harm her, she reported that at first she thought she would hit the attacker with a shoe. But then she said to herself: "Malala, if you hit a Talib, then there would be no difference between you and the Talib. You must not treat others with cruelty...You must fight others through peace and through dialogue and through education...I would tell him how important education is and that I would even want education for your children as well. That's what I want to tell you. Now do what you want." The following day, I noticed that during the night, somebody had stolen my doormat. My first reaction was anger at the people who do not respect other people's property. But

then I realized that if Malala could respond with love to somebody who would threaten her physical integrity, I certainly could do the same to somebody to takes a doormat.
